Equipment:

- **Equipment Required for all practices and games:** Size 4 ball, shingaurds, cleats (no football cleats or baseball cleats that have toe cleat). Please write name on ball. **Please be sure to bring ball to every practice and game.**
- No jewelry, no tapeovers, no hard splints or casts.
- **Water, water, water.** Please ensure your player brings plenty of water to practices and games to ensure they are properly hydrated. Please put name on bottle, even on disposables.

Weekly Practices (2 times/wk) beginning August 3, 2010:

- **Saticoy Elementary, Tuesday and Thursday, likely 4:30pm – 6:30pm.** We are considering 5-7. Time will be shifted earlier as dusk arrives sooner.
- Please arrive early - please remember the water, water, water
- Please assist coach with bringing equipment to field, and setup
- **No restrooms available at Saticoy school. Be prepared.** If player needs restroom during practice, the closest place is Saticoy Golf Course, or Huntsinger Park.
- Please help during practices – shagging balls, help set up goals and cones. Help is particularly important during initial setup, and being on hand to shag balls shot on goal during practices.
- Pickup on time **and by known member of the family unless discussed with coach in advance.** Please do not send some random to pick up your child without advance notice to coach or team mom, as it puts us in an uncomfortable position. Your child's safety is always of greatest importance.
